

LO: I can use 'did' and 'done' accurately.

#### Success criteria:

- I know the simple past tense of 'do'.
- I know whether to use 'did' or 'done' in my writing.
- I know whether to use 'did' or 'done' in spoken language.
- I know how to use 'did' to form a question and add emphasis.



'Do' is a common verb in English.

'Did' and 'done' are the past tenses of the verb 'do'. In the simple past tense, the correct use of 'do' is:

# did

I did

you did

we did

they did

he did

she did

it did

**NOTE**: It is **not** 'I done', 'we done', etc.

Using the verb 'done' always requires a helping word.

# Examples:

#### have done

I have done

you have done

we have done


they have done

#### has done

he has done

she has done

it has done

did

done

D I \_\_\_\_ not enjoy that film.

did
