
Reading


- * Reading and HFW (suggested activity on website)

- *Each week the children will be set 7 phonics spellings and 3 HFW.



What is phonics?

- *A way to teach reading
- *Helps children hear, identify and use different sounds
- *Helps children to begin to write

- *Linguistic Phonics




Linguistic Phonics

- *Provides children with strategies to help them problem solve words for both reading and writing.
- *Split up into 6 different stages
- *In P1 the children will have covered stages 1 and 2
- *In P2 we revise stages 1 and 2 and work towards stage 6.

- *One letter one sound
- *Beginning to read simple words

*E.g., is, and, hat dog







- *Continue to focus on one letter one sound
- *Building longer words

*E.g., sand, frog, milk





*Multi-syllable words










- *Sounds represented by more than one letter
- *ff, II, ss, zz











Stage 5 and 6

*Sounds represented by more than one spelling pattern


- *'oa' The old boat can go slowly.
