PERMA in P3



Positivity- Growth mindset, Merit marks, table points/pom poms/ pupil of the week star of the day, stickers, positive praise, Principal's approval 😊

Engagement- broad and varied curriculum

Relationships- children, teachers, support staff, lunchtime supervisors, caretaker, Principal

Meaning- KWL-pupil voice, traffic light trays to encourage pupils to self-assess their work

Achievement- celebrating success, merit marks, pupil of the week, weekly spelling and mental maths revision, pompoms, out of school achievements, school nativity, Harvest/Easter services

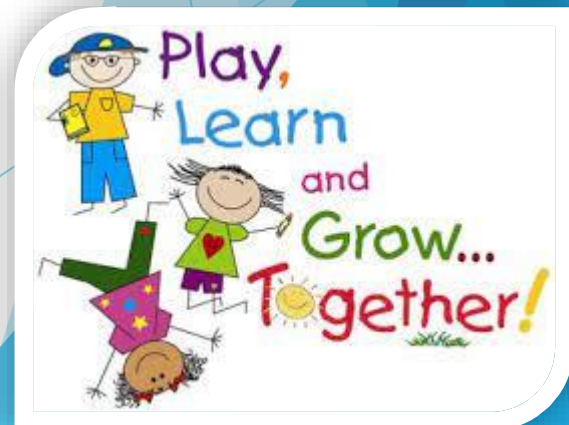
